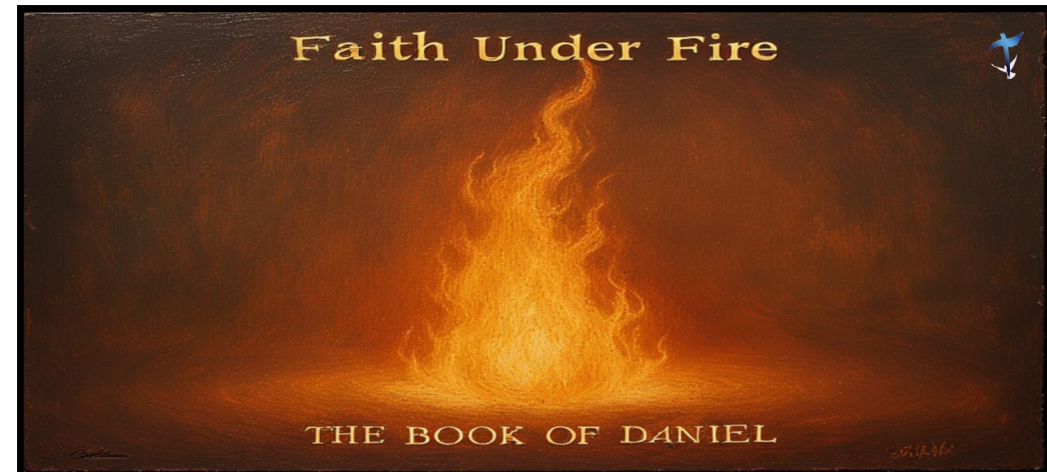

Daniel 1 – The Land of the Lost

Today we embark on a new sermon series in the Old Testament book of Daniel. This extraordinary book begins during the period when the people of Judah were taken into exile, around 605 BC. It follows the experiences of several men from Judah who were given important positions within a foreign administration, yet who sought to remain faithful to the LORD their God despite significant threats to their lives.

The book of Daniel has many fascinating features, including the fact that the original text contains two languages: Hebrew (the native language of Israel) and Aramaic (the administrative language of Babylon and Persia). This shows that the book is intended not only for the traditional people of God – those from Judah – but also for people in the surrounding nations. Although God allowed the people of Judah to be taken into exile as part of his judgement, he remains firmly in control of the events in history, working to bring about his purposes and plans. The take-home message for us, reading this book in the 21st century after Jesus, is that although kingdoms rise and fall, God remains sovereign and will never leave his faithful people.
