John 8:12-30 - Come and see ...the light of the world

When Jesus states in v12, "I am the light of the world", this is the second of seven "I am..." sayings in John's gospel. The context of these "I am" sayings began when Jesus was speaking with the Samaritan woman by the well (in Jn 4:1-26). The woman told Jesus that she believed the Messiah (called Christ) will explain everything about God to the people. To which Jesus literally replied, "I am!", harking back to Exodus 3:14 when God revealed to Moses His name, "I am who I am." And so with the 7 "I am..." sayings in John's gospel we not only learn about Jesus' intimate connection to God the Father, but we also learn what Jesus brings to us as he reveals God to all people. So here we see that Jesus brings the light of God to lead the world out of darkness and into the way of truth. John invites us to come and see the light of the world.


