

'Beware the Villains' - 2 Peter 2:1-22

As we enter chapter 2 of Peter's second letter we discover he moves quickly to warn his readers of the danger of false teachers and their false teaching. It is telling that Peter uses a lot of words in this letter to demonstrate the judgement that stands ahead of those who would pervert the message of the gospel. He is either passionately against those who would teach false doctrine, or passionately protective of the church family, or both. However we view what was going on in Peter's day, we can see the connections with false teachers in our day. In the end, the only way we can be protected from false teaching is by knowing the apostles' message well, and by testing what we hear today with the testimony of the Bible.
