

'The Living Word'

Last week in our series on Anglican Distinctives we thought about the Biblical concept of the Holy Trinity. Our God is one God, and yet three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. And although this teaching is impossible to perfectly illustrate, because God stands outside of his creation, there is one Biblical illustrations to help us understand the Trinity. God the Father spoke creation into being (Genesis 1), Jesus is the Living Word of God (John 1:1), and the Holy Spirit is the breath of God ('spirit' in Greek and Hebrew can also be translated breath or wind). This is the only Biblical illustration of the Trinity. This week we will be focusing on the second person of the Trinity, Jesus, the Living Word. And it is Jesus who is fully divine, and fully human – that is, of one substance with the Father, and yet taking on the form of a human to reveal to us the nature and character of God. May we grow this week in our love for the Living Word of God, King Jesus.
