

### **Profit & Loss Statement**

As we enter chapter 3 of this letter to the Philippians, you may think that Paul might be just about finished with what he has to say. However, there are still important things to warn this church about. There are well qualified people who have entered the church with a message that stands against the Gospel of Christ. These people stand in contrast to Timothy and Epaphroditus (mentioned last week, vv19-25) and place confidence in their own achievements without regard to the work of Christ.

We also read about these same people in Acts 15, and Paul addresses the issue more fully in his letter to the Galatians (Ch 3). But here Paul assures the Philippians that although he himself is well qualified, his own salvation is solely reliant on the work of Christ. The question for us is, do we also believe this?
