### New Faith - John 4:43-54

Toward the end of John's account of Jesus' life we read the purpose statement for this gospel. In John 20:24-29 he relays the moment when one of Jesus' disciples, a man named Thomas, goes from doubting Jesus rose from the dead to believing in the resurrection and that Jesus is the Christ. Thomas had refused to believe until he saw Jesus for himself. Jesus concludes their interaction by saying, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed". In today's reading we meet a royal official who takes Jesus at his word and believes in his power without seeing immediately the results of Jesus' promise. It's not until later the royal official's faith is affirmed. In the same way as readers of John's account we are encourage to believe in Jesus although we do not see.
