'The Lamb of God'

The first chapter of this gospel is the tale of two Johns. We have the prophet John, the baptiser, who stands as the last prophet from Old Testament days. And we have the apostle John, the author of this book, and beloved disciple of the Lord Jesus. Both Johns bear witness to the identity and the significance of the man Jesus Christ.

John the Baptist is in no doubt that Jesus is far greater than he. Verse 15 already quoted his assessment saying, "He who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me." John knew that he was unworthy to even untie Jesus' sandals (v27). But his clearest declaration comes in v29 when he calls Jesus "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world." And it will be the apostle John who will witness Jesus' sacrificial death on the cross for the sins of the world. The witness of the two Johns act like book-ends as they introduce us to the Lord Jesus.
