'Pure Devotion' – Psalm 26

Today's Psalm shows the extraordinary devotion of one man to his God, the LORD. Despite the distraction of others and the manipulation of the world the Psalmist claims to have led a blameless life (vv1 and 11), to have trusted in the LORD without wavering (v1b), to have walked continually in his truth (v3), and to have avoided the influence of evil men (vv4-5). The only person I can think of who lived like this is the Lord Jesus Christ. And yet this Psalm is attributed to the hand of King David. The comfort I get from this Psalm, is that King David continued to require God's vindication (v1), his love and truth (v3), his presence (v8), and his redemption and mercy (v11). The only way we can stand on level ground is by being devoted to him.




GOSPEL PARTNERSHIP:
