

**Daniel 7-8 – A Heavenly Perspective**

So far we have seen that the Book of Daniel is carefully structured in the way its chapters are arranged. Chapters 4 and 5 are linked as a study of human pride: King Nebuchadnezzar (ch. 4) was humbled because of his pride, whereas King Belshazzar (ch. 5) was judged for refusing to humble himself. Chapters 3 and 6 are linked as accounts of faithful men who chose obedience to God above compliance to their kings. In both chapters God miraculously delivers His servants from certain death. Chapters 2 and 7 are also connected because each contains a vision about the future of earthly kingdoms. Although kingdoms rise and fall throughout history, the stone (ch. 2) and the Son of Man (ch. 7) both come from God and ultimately rule over all earthly kingdoms. Finally, chapters 1 and 8 – written in a different language to chapters 2-7 – can also be linked. Together they remind the Judean exiles to remain faithful to God during difficult times, because He is sovereign over all things, including the future. Therefore, we too are called to humbly obey and trust our sovereign God.

\* Ministry reports were received, including the adoption of the parish financial statements for January and February.


\* Organ maintenance as once again brought to the attention of the wardens.
