


The Day of the Lord – Isaiah 2

The opening chapter of Isaiah, which we looked at last week, introduces the main message of the book, transformation is required, a call to repentance. But chapter 2 introduces a theme which will be regularly referred to in the first half of Isaiah and forms the basis of this call to change. Chapter 2 introduces us to the day when all other gods will be shown for what they really are, and the Lord God will rightly be exalted alone (vv11 & 17). In the end all who exalt themselves above the one true God will be humbled as they meet Him face-to-face. Therefore, Isaiah warns us that it is better to think rightly about ourselves and others in the light of God's power and majesty before that day when we will all meet Him.
