Ministry Morsel

After arriving back from an enjoyable 5 days at CMS Summer School, I was shocked to hear this week of the sudden death of Cardinal George Pell. The news of his death came on the same day that two teenage girls were buried in Quirindi, a place we lived for 3 years. The two girls died suddenly a few days after Christmas while boating on Lake Keepit. And, of course, we would have also heard the terrible news of those 3 Western Australian children orphaned on Christmas morning when their family car flipped and their parents we killed. In all these events sudden death shatters a holiday season that is meant for refreshment.

When I think about it, my guess is that these tragic events could have easily involved one of us. How often have we been praying for a member undergoing surgery, or in hospital for various reasons? Or how often are we enjoying life by the water maybe inches from danger? Or how often do we take a quick drive down the highway to visit family? The reality is sudden death could easily over come any one of us.

Life is so fragile. Death can impact any family on any given day. As we take in news about such tragedies, we must respond to two important questions. Firstly, am I prepared to meet God face-to-face if I am to experience sudden death? And secondly, do my family and friends know enough about the God they will one day meet? If life is that fragile, we would be fools if we didn't for a moment take stock of our lives and listen to the warnings of Jesus.

The Bible urges us to be prepared. Jesus calls us to be ready at any moment to meet him. And as Jesus calls us to be ready to meet him, he also urges us to warn others of the great danger of dying unprepared. So, let us continue in our local community to make every effort to introduce people to King Jesus and preparing them for eternity.




GOSPEL PARTNERSHIP:
