The Bread Of Life – John 6:41-59

Firstly, after mistaking Jesus to potentially be their earthly King, the crowd who had followed him to the temple in Capernaum, continued to press Jesus to satisfy them with heavenly bread (v34). But we must see here that what they were asking for was not what Jesus was offering to give. And so Jesus seeks to clear up the crowd's misunderstanding of who he is and why he has come. However, the irony continues to drip from the passage as the crowd confers with each other about Jesus' mother, and earthly father (v42). If they truly knew Jesus, they would know who his father truly is, God the Father.

Again, we hear echos of John 1. v11, "He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him." v18 "No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known."
