#### Salvation for Jerusalem - Isaiah 37

With the threat of an Assyrian invasion fully realised, the nation of Judah is virtually destined to be destroyed. And as the taunts of the Assyrian field commander reaches the ears of Judah's King, there is only one thing left to do. In an extraordinary moment in the Book of Isaiah we are allowed into the prayer life of King Hezekiah. He makes it a priority to go to the temple and bring this distressing moment before the Lord. His prayer (vv16-20), as we look a little closer, is less about himself, and more about God. Hezekiah is more concerned about God's honour than he is about his own future. As we bring our prayer requests before God, Hezekiah's model is an important one to follow.
