

'Symbols'

There are many symbols on show whenever you enter a church building. Most of these symbols, or visible signs, tell the story of some aspect of the Christian faith. Some symbols are helpful. Some are totally misunderstood. And some might even be deemed unnecessary. Article XXV, of the Thirty Nine Articles of Religion, states, "There are two Sacraments ordained of Christ our Lord in the Gospel, that is to say, Baptism, and the Supper of the Lord." And so Anglicans believe that according to the Bible there are only two symbols deemed by Jesus as necessary for our gathering together. The symbol of Baptism, a sign of our new resurrected life in Christ, and the symbol of Communion, a memorial meal pointing to Jesus' death on the cross for our sins. And so at the heart of these two foundational symbols is the gospel message, Jesus' death and resurrection.
