## Pressing on to the Goal

The Apostle Paul's warning against false teachers at the beginning of chapter 3, and his rejection of his own fleshly achievements, show us Paul's undivided devotion to the mission of Jesus. And in verses 12 to 21 of this chapter we will see Paul's vision and focus is fixed on the age to come, rather than on the world around him.

Paul understands the direction of God's call on his life (heavenward, v14), he recognises where his true citizenship resides (in heaven, v20), and he looks forward to that moment when his temporary body is transformed into something glorious (the resurrected body, v21).
