John 7:25-44 - Come and see ... the one who was sent

Everyone has an opinion. Everyone has a position. Everyone has their own views of things. But that does not mean that everyone is right! Or that everyone is set in their views. After all, when you remember back to when you were younger, there are many things you might be embarrassed to admit you believed. By verses 40-43 of our chapter this morning the crowds in Jerusalem were struggling with what they thought about Jesus. And you can see this with all the questions that John narrates for us. Could he be the Prophet? Maybe he is the Messiah? Where is the Messiah to come from? What do the scriptures say about this? Verse 43 concludes, "Thus the people were divided because of Jesus." Again, the irony in John's account is extraordinary, and especially when Jesus' words are so decisive. Will we believe that Jesus is the one sent from God?

* A reassessment of the process for counting and the banking offertory monies was initiated.




