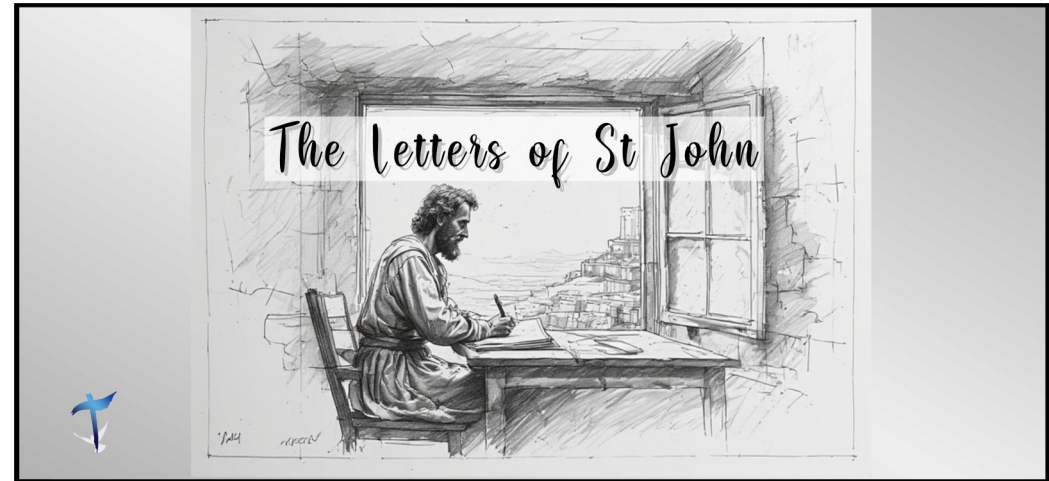

Protecting the Peace of the Church

The letters of 1, 2 & 3 John are deeply theological but also deeply personal. John's letters are set against the backdrop of heresies threatening the purity, peace and purpose of the church. Last week, David walked us through the theological treatise of 1 John - and its focus on the nature of Jesus, the impact of sin, and the character of true love.

This week, John narrows his focus to one church in particular. He writes a more personal letter; exalting and encouraging them on how some of them are living but also warning them of threats. There are somethings that do not and should not mix. Oil and water, open tomato sauce bottles and pantries, heretics and believers. John (the elder) writes that they will not be deceived but remain obedient in the truth. A message vital for us today just as it was for John's original hearers.

GOSPEL PARTNERSHIP: QUIZ WORX:

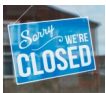

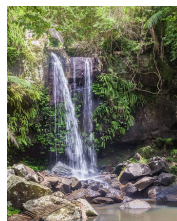

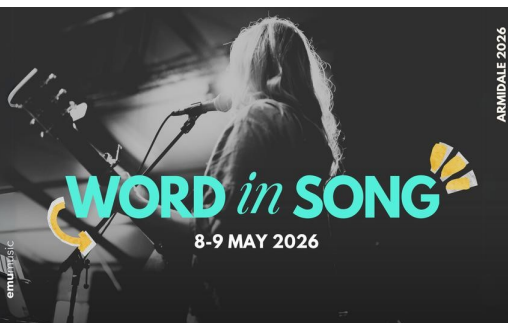
