

New Life in Christ – Colossians 3:1-17

Last week, as we looked at Colossians 2 together, we saw the Apostle Paul addressing a serious danger facing the Christians in Colossae. He warned them about false teachings in the church – teachings that could lead people away from Christ through deceptive philosophy, human tradition, and ineffectual rules. Paul's message was clear: Don't be taken captive. Don't let anyone judge you. Don't be disqualified by these false teachings. Now, as we move into Colossians 3, Paul shifts from a negative warning, to positive instruction for living the Christian life. He calls us to set our hearts and minds on things above, and not on earthly things. We are to lay aside ungodly behaviours and attitudes, and put on the virtues of a life transformed by Christ. We are called to forgive as the Lord has forgiven us, to love as Christ has loved us, and to let the peace of Christ – and the message of Christ – fill our hearts and shape our lives, so that we may be a blessing others. This is to be our new life in Christ.
