### It's Make or Break - Isaiah 8

As we make our way through Isaiah 7-12 we often cover poetry speaking about the judgement of God on the Nation of Judah. This prophetic word was spoken to a specific people at a specific time. In Isaiah 8, approximately 735BC, ominous signs of judgement stands against the nations threatening Judah. This serves as a warning to Judah's king not to make his own back-up plans but to trust solely in the LORD. And so as Judah watches God's judgement unfold on those nations, we watch God's judgement unfold on Judah, warning us against half-hearted devotion.

As we read this chapter the question for us is, will we ignore the prophetic warning as King Ahaz did? It's make, or break.
