Don't Give Up – 2 Thessalonians 1

We are privileged to have a significant amount of information about the early Christian church in Thessalonica. Not only do we possess two letters written by the Apostle Paul, but we also have Dr. Luke's account of its founding in Acts 17, during Paul's 2nd missionary journey. From the beginning, these new believers faced opposition and persecution from both Gentile and Jewish agitators. As they responded to the gospel, their lives were completely transformed — they turned away from false idols and chose to serve the living and true God (1 Thess. 1:9). This persecution produced a resilient faith, but also stirred within them a deep longing for Christ's return. In response, Paul wrote to encourage them to persevere in the faith. The opening chapter of his second letter reminds the early church that persecution is to be expected as we follow in Jesus' footsteps, and that in God's perfect timing, their suffering will end and His justice will be fulfilled. So, don't give up.
