Gospel Focus

Chapter 2 of Paul's letter to Titus begins with clear teaching for various groups within the church family. Titus is to ensure that older men and women, along with younger men and women, and even Christian servant or slaves, are aware of how our behaviour ought to be in line with our beliefs. As Titus teaches what is in accord with sound doctrine (verse 1), the reason for living out this teaching is expressed at the end of verse 10, "...so that in every way they (the various groups in the church) will make the teaching about God our Savior attractive."

In the end our good and godly behaviour does not earn our favour with God, rather our good and godly behaviour will attract outsiders to the Gospel. It is worth considering whether our behaviour as a church family is achieving this.

KAIROS PRISON MINISTRY

Kairos is a movement born within evangelical churches to take the love of Jesus into those in prison. Teams of Christians from many churches are gathered and train together for a

number of weeks before they are sent into a correctional centre for what is called a short course (5 days). This team gives talks, prays, sings and has fun encouraging the residents to feel the love of Jesus in action. Usually residents experience Jesus love through the bonded team and in the knowledge that folk worldwide are praying for them. They receive gifts such as copious numbers of biscuits and slices and letters of encouragement. After the week they are able to meet together to talk about their experience and to keep a check on their lives as far as prayer, study and action are concerned. Zoom meetings can occur with team members.

Kairos is a great outreach and offers much as you give yourself to his service. If you are interested in finding out more see Pam Stone who is a chaplain for Kairos 4 at Kempsey in September.
