Isaiah 21-23 – The God who Brings Victory

As we come to chapters 21-23 of Isaiah the prophecies (sometimes called oracles) continue, but this time the recipient of these prophecies are a little more vague. For example, 21:1 "A prophecy against the Desert by the Sea:", or 21:11 "A prophecy against Dumah (literally 'the silence'):", and 22:1 "A prophecy against the Valley of Vision:". But clearly God has a number of nations in mind including Babylon (21:9b), Judah (22:8) and the people of Tyre (23:1). Yet, what is surprising about these prophecies of judgement is that after a time things will return back to normal (as before). And more than that, God's people will receive the benefit of this transformation. As in 23:18, "Yet her profit and her earnings will be set apart for the LORD; ... Her profits will go to those who live before the LORD,..." In the Lord's plan, after judgement comes renewal and transformation.
