A testimony to the joy we all feel in our hearts at God's answer to our prayers and God's provision for the next season of ministry leadership at Northern Beaches Anglicans.

The **practical details** are that Simon will commence as **Rector on December 19** at which time I will be licenced as Associate Priest until my **formal retirement on April 30** next year. I will commence Annual Leave and Long Service Leave on December 19 which concludes on April 9. For three weeks I will **oversee the Parish** while the Reeve family enjoys Annual Leave. Our **final service** will be the Combined Service on **Sunday April 30**.

I trust that now there will be **shift of leadership focus** on the part of the parish family as I step down and back (sounds like a dangerous physical manoeuvre for an ageing body).

God willing, Leone and I **look forward** to continuing to be part of a very **precious Christian family** in the years ahead.
