# 'The Teacher'

From the testimony of John the Baptiser, we are quickly introduced to the testimony of Jesus' disciples. In our passage this morning (John 1:35-51) we see five people in quick succession commit to following Jesus. The first two, Andrew, and we suspect the author John, followed Jesus at the suggestion of the Baptiser. Immediately, Andrew's brother, Simon Peter joins the group, and then while travelling to Galilee Philip, and eventually his brother, Nathanael, also join in. We find out later that John's brother, James, becomes one of the disciples as well. In one sense it seems that this growing group of disciples are all close friends, business partners (fishermen), and brothers. And, as we know, this is how the Christian message spreads today in our modern communities. So it is important to pray for your friends, pray for your colleagues, and pray for your family. But don't forget to introduce them to King Jesus yourself, so that they can be prepared for eternity.


## GOSPEL PARTNERSHIP: HOLIDAY KIDS' CLUB
