

### The Week before Christmas

Friends, as we enter this week before Christmas, we acknowledge with grief the horrific events of last Sunday evening at Bondi Beach in Sydney. Like many across our nation, we are shocked and deeply saddened by reports of this terrorist attack targeting innocent Jewish lives on Australian shores. Our hearts are broken. How, then, should Christians respond to such news? First, we are called to pray – for the families of the victims, for the injured, and for all those who are traumatised – asking the God of all comfort to sustain those who grieve and suffer (2 Corinth. 1:3-7). Second, while the moral evil of such violence is clear and must never be excused, Jesus warns us against self-righteous judgement. Instead, he calls us to examine our own hearts in repentance, remembering the fragility of life and our need for God's mercy (Luke 13:1-5). Finally, Scripture assures us that God remains sovereign, even when events defy our understanding. We trust that he is at work for ultimate good (Romans 8:28-9), as we long for Christ's return to renew our broken world.


