The Way of Service – John 13:1-17

At the end of John 12, we hear the final words of Jesus' public ministry, inviting unbelievers to come and see that he is the Son of God and to believe in him for eternal life. As we enter chapter 13, however, Jesus' ministry turns to preparing his followers for life as his disciples. The setting of the *Upper Room Discourse* is the Jewish festival of Passover, which celebrates and commemorates the nation's rescue from slavery in Egypt. Ironically, the Teacher of this band of disciples, fully aware that the Father had given all things into his hands (v3), takes on the role of a lowly servant. By washing his disciples' feet, Jesus provides a vivid object lesson of what it means for his followers to serve one another. He then tells them, "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet" (v14). While this moment is a powerful example of humble service, it also points forward to the cross – the ultimate act of self-giving love and service. Jesus is the servant King, leading and teaching his followers to imitate him.
