

Conduct Worthy of the Gospel

The apostle Paul has been explaining to his supporters in Philippi his current situation, which may seem on the surface as being a little dire. However, we have seen Paul's thankfulness to God and positive outlook on his situation noting that whatever happens it will be a win-win situation for the gospel and for himself.

However, in verse 27 of this first chapter, we see Paul shift from reassuring the Philippians about his current situation, to encouraging the Philippians to live lives in "... a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ". Of course, Paul has been their example of what this looks like. But as we will see, and as we reach the central theme of this letter, the Lord Jesus stands as the ultimate example and model for the Philippians, for Paul and for us.
