Psalm 27 continues the theme of this section of the Psalms, of confidence in the Lord, and joy in his presence. But, as is so common with the Psalms, David calls upon God to help in his hour of need. Verse 12 highlights this point, "Do not turn me over to the desire of my foes, for false witnesses rise up against me, spouting malicious accusations." It's not hard to see the events of Jesus' crucifixion in the words of these Psalms. And yet both the Psalmist, and the Lord Jesus, never lost sight of the character of God. Verse 13, "I remain confident of this: I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living." May our eyes remain fixed on the goodness of God in Jesus.
