# John 10:1-21 – Come and see ...the Good Shepherd

The people of God in the Bible are often referred to as sheep (eg. Is. 53:6). In some ways this is an interesting observation and illustration for us to consider. But the Bible also refers to the leaders of God's people as shepherds. King David was a shepherd, and even today Ministers are sometimes called Pastors (think pastoral work). And sadly the Bible shows a history of Israel's shepherds not taking care of the sheep entrusted into their care. Our reading from Ezekiel 34 shows us the disdain that God has for those who neglect His people. But thankfully our God promises to be the ultimate shepherd, like in Psalm 23. In John 10 we see exactly how he achieves this. He sent Jesus, the Good Shepherd, to call out and then lay his life down for his sheep. And so, if we are to be God's people we are to follow God's appointed shepherd.
