

**Daniel 9 – An Earthly Recognition**

As we have seen throughout this book, Daniel – the Judean exile – has been central to the events in the courts of the Babylonian and later Medo-Persian Empire. Taken as a young boy, he was trained for royal service (1:3-5), called upon to advise kings (4:8; 5:12), and eventually appointed as an administrator over a third of the kingdom (6:1-2). Throughout it all, God has clearly protected and provided for this humble, devoted man. Against this backdrop, Daniel 9 offers a glimpse into the inner life of this godly man. Verses 2 and 3 show that Daniel had never forgotten his roots. He continues meditating on the Scriptures and turns to God in earnest prayer as he reflects on the state of God's people. He longs to see God fulfil his promises and accomplish his purposes for the Jewish nation. Yet he is strikingly honest, confessing their sins and identifying with their failures before God. As we consider Daniel's character, may we follow his example – pursuing a disciplined and devoted life, while earnestly praying for God's kingdom to come and his purposes to be fulfilled.


