

'Predestination'

Today we reach the final of our Anglican Distinctives, a series looking at what Anglicans believe, and why we do the things we do. And the final theme in our series is also the second of the Thirty-nine Articles that is to bring "unspeakable comfort" to the Christian person. Now, to be clear, the theme of 'Predestination' is a fairly complex and controversial thing, even amongst Christians. In every Bible Study group I have been a part of we have discussed at length what this teaching might mean, and how it might affect our thoughts and actions. But the framers of the Thirty-nine Articles were right to ensure that Anglicans know the precious comfort that comes from faith in the all sovereign God revealed on every page of the Bible. It certainly brought hope and comfort to Joseph (in Genesis 37-50) through the mistreatment he experienced in his life. And it will bring hope and comfort to us through whatever struggles we may face.
