Salvation for Hezekiah – Isaiah 38

After a stunning victory against the Assyrian King in chapter 37 we are taken to another time and another crisis in King Hezekiah's life. Isaiah 38 tells us of the personal health problems of the king as he becomes ill, even to the point of death. Again we enter into the prayer life of Hezekiah as he humbly turns to God in prayer. Scholars mostly agree that this event actually happened before the Assyrian crisis, and may have been the point at which Hezekiah was prepared for facing the larger troubles. And it is Hezekiah's reflection on his illness that confirms this for us. Verses 15-20 show us an incredible insight into the experience of this suffering king. It was in the anguish of his soul that he was able to find life in his saviour. Of course in the following chapters Isaiah (40-50) will go on to speak of another suffering servant who was still to come who would not only offer salvation to Kings and nations, but to the whole world.
