John 7:45-52 – Come and see ...the one to be believed

We find in John's biography of Jesus' life an intentional focusing on the response of people toward Jesus' miraculous signs, and his teaching. This morning, as we reach the end of chapter 7 we discover a number of incredible responses to Jesus' appearance at the Festival of Tabernacles. It is the response of the temple police that stands out. These men, who were to maintain order during the festival, were aware of Jesus' attendance at the feast, and had obviously heard Jesus' teaching. Although these police might have known that the Jewish leaders were concern about Jesus, their response to his attendance was to say, "No one ever spoke the way this man does!" (v46). His teaching must have been captivating, his content could not have been controversial, and his manner was not threatening. Yet, some minds were already made up! Are ours?
