

New Life With One Another – Colossians 3:18-4:18

So today we turn to the final chapter and a half of Colossians – a letter that reminds its readers of the supremacy of Christ (1:18) and calls them to live a life worthy of him (1:10). Throughout this letter we have been warned about those who would distort the truth about Jesus by adding human traditions, worldly wisdom and ineffectual rules to the gospel (2:8). Instead, the Christian is called to set their hearts and minds on heavenly things, and putting off worldly ways and putting on the character of God, seeking in all things to honour the name of Jesus (3:17). This brings us to the final instructive section of our letter – an exhortation for individuals and households to live ordered and peaceful lives with the aim of winning the outsider to Christ. For Christ is supreme over all, and our desire should be to see all people make him supreme in their lives.
