Isaiah 24-27 – The God who wipes away all evil

We often hear people say that the world is getting worse. Society is breaking down, national leaders are growing increasingly arrogant, innocent people are suffering and the powerful are becoming more corrupt. But Isaiah 1-27 seems to indicate that the world has been this way for over 2600 years. The world is not growing more wicked as time goes on, it is just that our eyes are being opened more to the evil around us, and even to the evil within. Chapters 24-27 show us that God will not allow evil to reign over the earth forever. It is in his plan to removed the power of sin from the world, and to remove the effect of sin on our world. This means that all who participate and contribute to the evil in our world will face his judgement. The question for us is, will we learn from God's righteous judgement, or will we continue to take God's grace for granted? (Is. 26:9-10)

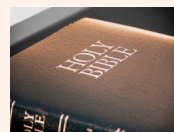
