# 'My Strength and My Shield' - Psalm 28

In thinking and reading about Psalm 28 I came across an interesting statement in the Old Testament book of 2 Samue19. The commander of King David's army, his nephew Joab, at one point says to David (v7), "...This will be worse for you than all the calamities that have come on you from your youth till now." Now, there is an important context to Joab's statement in the 2 Samuel account, but what interests me, and relates to Psalm 28, is that David has faced significant trials and "calamities" since his youth. Understanding this makes his cry in Psalm 28 a lot more powerful. David has developed a pattern of turning to God, particularly in his trials, because God has proven to be his strength and shield. So who do we turn to?
