The Way of Betrayal – John 13:18-30

The moment that led to Judas' betrayal of Jesus occurs immediately after Jesus washed his disciples' feet. While Jesus was modelling and teaching selfless love to his followers, Judas is plotting evil – showing no regard for his friends and remaining blind to the eternal consequences of his actions. In many ways, we face the same choices as Judas. Will we embrace the teachings of Jesus? Will we respond obediently to all he has to say? Will we model his selfless love and humble service? Or will we continue to pursue selfish gain, worldly security, and temporal pleasures? The sobering reality is that we all have the potential to betray Jesus. Yet the striking feature of this account is that Jesus knew exactly what was happening. He knew who would betray him. And what was intended for evil, God used to accomplish the ultimate good. In the end, Judas' decision to betray Jesus formed part of God's sovereign plan to save his people. Judas remained fully accountable for his actions, while Jesus remained perfectly obedient to his Father's plan to redeem the world.
