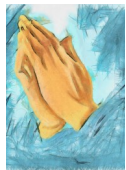

**John 10:22-42 – Come and see ...the one to believe**

Our Bible passage today concludes quite a larger section of John's account of Jesus' life. And if we summarise the last 6 chapters we find a repeating cycle in John's account. In chapter 5 Jesus performs a miracle, then he explains who he is, before they try to kill him. In chapter 6 he performs a miracle, thousands believe him, then he explains who he is, before they grumble and walk away. In chapter 7, Jesus confuses them, then he explains things, and lots of people believe in him, before he explains some more of who he is, then the ones who believe in him decide they want to kill him (chapter 8). Then in chapters 9 and 10, we see Jesus perform a miracle. We see the authorities try and rub out the evidence, then Jesus explains who he is, and then they try to kill him again. Although we are right back where we began, John over the last 6 chapters has been able to allow Jesus' words to show us exactly who he is. The ball is now in our court. We have all the evidence. We have heard Jesus' words. We now need to make the decision on who to believe.

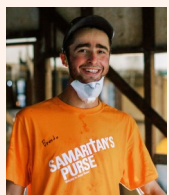

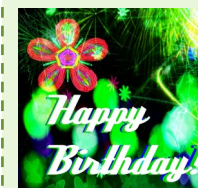
