

Daniel 10-12 – A Vision of Hope

This week, we come to the end of our sermon series in the book of Daniel. It has been a remarkable journey, reflecting on how Daniel and his friends honoured God while living as exiles in a foreign land. In the narrative section (chapters 1–6), we see that God reveals deep and hidden things, even the future; he is able to rescue his faithful people – yet calls them to obedience whether or not deliverance comes; and he is sovereign over all kingdoms and all of history. In the symbolic visions (chapters 7–12), these same truths are deepened: earthly kingdoms rise and fall, often oppressing God's people, yet God remains in complete control. His people are called to endure suffering faithfully, trusting in his promise of final deliverance, resurrection, and the everlasting kingdom of the one like a son of man. Therefore, as God's people today, we are called to walk humbly and live with steadfast allegiance to him in a turbulent world, trusting not only in his present rule over history but in his ultimate plan to bring about final justice and salvation.
