CHURCH OF ENGLAND CHALLENGES:

Some of you may be aware of the fracture that is deepening and continuing to damage the Church of England. In the last week there have been significant steps pushed forward by many bishops for the blessing of same-sex relationships within church services. This is causing great heartache among orthodox Anglicans who wish to continue to be a part of the Church of England but are seeking to remain faithful to Biblical teaching. Sadly, many have already left the church over the issues.

These changes **do not** currently affect the Anglican Church of Australia. The dioceses around Australia are bound by our own constitution which remains separate from the Church of England.

Currently our doctrine of marriage according to our constitution remains between one man and one woman. However, these changes in the Church of England do two things. Firstly, the changes place strain on our relationship with the worldwide communion, under the leadership of the Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby. Already there are dioceses, and bishops from the global south seeking to distance themselves from the Church of England. And the interesting fact is these dioceses are not small, rogue, splinter groups, but actually are much larger churches than the Church of England itself.

Secondly, and more significantly, this move will put greater pressure on our diocese to align itself with such changes and swim with the culture of the day. Currently our bishop has asked the clergy of this diocese to wait for bishops across Australia to agree before any change in practice.

However, he has also indicated that there is no Church Law against such practices.

Friends, as orthodox Anglicans seeking to be faithful to Biblical teaching, please pray for God's hand to be on the Church of England, and the Anglican Church of Australia as it faces this crisis. If there is an irreparable break in the fellowship of the worldwide communion, it will be extremely heartbreaking, but we will still be able to serve God as we have done in our community. But if there is a break of fellowship inside the Australian Church, then we will all be faced with many difficult questions. Now is the time to pray!
