

DAVID'S FINAL MINISTRY MORSEL

One treasured possession on my many bookshelves is a large print 1978 An Australian Prayer Book. The Prayer Book has a beautiful crafted, handstitched leather cover with a cross on the front. The leatherwork done by the husband of one of Dad's teaching staff. He suffered severely from depression and found great encouragement in making the cover. Written inside the cover in Dad's school teacher cursive handwriting. The following: 2 Corinthians 4 To our dear David. May your ministry be long and blessed. Our love Mum, Dad, Sally 29-11-81 (the date on which I was made a Deacon).

Ever since, Leone and I have always been thankful for the words of 2 Corinthians 4. Especially these words, For what we preach is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, and ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ. But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us. v5-7

A reminder that **today is not primarily about Leone and I**. But about **the Lord Jesus Christ and his church**. For it is God who **opens people's hearts** to see, know and follow Jesus. It is the **treasure of the gospel**, the good news about Jesus who died in our place, conquered death by rising from the dead, opening up, to those who believe, the gates of glory: eternal life in his presence.

As **jars of clay** we have had the **immense privilege** of guarding, proclaiming and living out the treasure of the gospel. A privilege that does not end today! The immense privilege of sharing our lives, and sharing in the lives of precious, precious people God has entrusted into our care. We are **thankful to God**, **beyond words**, for that privilege.

In Paul's farewell to the Ephesian elders he said, '*Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood.*' Acts 20:28 We love the church which was purchased with the blood of Christ.
