Our Praiseworthy God – Isaiah 12

Over the last month or so we have been working our way through chapters 7-12 of Isaiah, as part of a larger sermon series. And today we focus on this song of praise in chapter 12. And we could say that the opening 2 verses of this chapter are a summary of Isaiah's entire prophecy, and also a summary of the entire Bible. The first 10 chapters of Isaiah show us the judgement of God over Judah, and nations that surround her, against injustice and oppression. Chapter 11 speaks of the great day of redemption when the just judgement of God has been completed, and the earth has been returned to Eden. And chapter 12 is the eternal song of praise sung by us to our great God who has brought salvation through the root of Jesse, Jesus.


