### MINISTRY MORSEL

Getting tougher to share the true meaning of Christmas in our secular society. May Scott Blackwell's words assist us to share the Christian narrative.

"Christmas is not the **fairy story** of a **red-costumed fat man** in a flying sleigh. It is the **story of God** sending to earth a **little baby boy** to be born in a barn and **discovered** whilst sleeping in a manger by shepherds. Having seen the angels from heaven, and having **heard from the God** that rules both heaven and earth through them, the shepherds are required to **come to terms** with this truth: 'I will bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, who is Christ the Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger.' Luke 2:10-12

If the curious sign of the manger speaks of anything, it is that this Jesus-this Lord and Saviour- is humble and lowly of heart. As majestic as he will eventually be revealed to be, the reality is that he will never be too important for you to get to meet, know or understand. You will never be too small or too inferior for him. He is seriously concerned about you. Yes, he is 'God the Son'. But this is the God who out of love and compassion, bends down so that he might lift you up and show you how important you truly are in his eyes and within his heart. This is the man who lives a life exactly like yours, but in service to God, and who then surrenders that same life in service to you....

He is God the Son - whom all of us need to honour as our Lord (our king), just as the wise men from the East did. But he was also born to be a blessing to all who meet him and honour him: the rich and the poor, the young and the old, the local and the foreigner. This boy is born so that an amazing blessing from God might come to every man, woman and child who meets him and comes to know him. What then is this blessing?....It is the blessing of forgiveness, the blessing of new relationship, the blessing of life."
