# **Ministry Morsel**


We warmly welcome you to Northern Beaches Anglicans today.

This morning we return to our preaching series in the Gospel of Luke. We will be picking up from where we left off in chapter 15, and we will be following his biography through all the way to Easter.

You would remember that Dr Luke has been writing an historical account of the real Jesus. He spent the first 9 chapters showing us who Jesus is. His disciple, Peter, declares it clearly in Luke 9:20 where he says that Jesus is "God's Messiah", or in other words he is "God's anointed king".

From this point on in Dr Luke's account Jesus resolutely set his face toward Jerusalem (v51) where he knows he will die (v22).

It is this second half of Luke that we see Jesus preparing his disciples to take the message of King Jesus into the rest of the world. So, let's journey with them as we continue in the mission of our King.
