# A Gospel 'Son'

This morning we begin a new preaching series in the New Testament letter of Titus. Titus was one of Paul's most trusted partners in ministry, and although he is never mentioned in the book of Acts, there is one theory suggesting that he may have even been Dr Luke's brother (hence why he is not mentioned in Acts!!).

Regardless of his family connections, Titus was tasked with a special and important ministry of "straightening out" (1:5) the newly formed church on the island of Crete. God had equipped Titus for this role, and Paul's letter was to remind him of what the church needed, and to show the church community that Titus had the apostle's authority. And so as we read through this short letter over the next 5 weeks, we too are to recognise its authority to reform us as a Christian community.
