His Harvest - John 4:27-42

For many generations the Samaritan people had been separated from the Jews because of their corrupt and dishonouring religious beliefs and practices. But on that incredible day we have been reading about, when Jesus asked for a drink of water at Jacob's well near Sychar, we not only see the true identity of Jesus revealed to the Samaritan woman, as God's Messiah, but we also see many of her fellow town's folk come to believe in him. There are two important things to learn from what is described in this passage. Firstly, the woman's witness is integral to her fellow town's folk hearing about Jesus. And secondly, it was Jesus' words that brought about their faith in him. So let us be stirred on to keep up our part in this process by introducing people to King Jesus, and allowing his words to transform their lives.
