Destruction – Revelation 15-16

We are now deep into the Book of Revelation, wrestling with the imagery John saw in his apocalyptic vision. At this point, it is helpful to take a step back and see what is happening. John writes to seven first-century churches in what is now modern-day Türkiye, churches struggling with persecution, false teaching, and apathy (Rev. 1-3). John first sets before them the Heavenly throne room, where all of creation and God's people worship the Him and the Lamb, who alone is worthy to unfold history and accomplish God's purposes (Rev. 4-5). As the Lamb breaks the seven seals of the scroll, we see layers of judgement poured out upon the earth, while God's people are sealed and protected (Rev. 6-7). Then seven trumpets blast, bringing plagues that roll back God's good creation, yet God's message and people are vindicated (Rev. 8-11). Next, a series of signs reveal God's people being pursued as military and economic powers rule the world, while those who follow the Lamb are called to remain faithful (Rev. 12-14). This week we see seven angels pour out seven bowls of God's wrath as His final judgement comes upon the earth (Rev. 15-16). Yet the overall message is clear: in the midst of God's righteous judgement, His people remain secure as they follow Jesus, the Lamb, and faithfully bear witness to Him.
