'The Beginning'

Today we begin our new sermon series in the Gospel of John. This is often called the 4th gospel, not just because it comes 4th in the New Testament order of books, but because this biography of Jesus is very different to the other three gospels (Matthew, Mark and Luke). For one, it is not chronological. Not all books of the Bible, or even other ancient literary books, were written chronologically. Rather, as we see with John's Gospel, the author wants us to understand something more significant that just the order of events. This 4th gospel takes us through 7 signs and 7 speeches of Jesus that indicate who he is, and why he came. The Apostle John, the disciples whom Jesus loved, brings us these signs and speeches in order that we "...may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing (we) may have life in his name." (John 20:31) So the intent of this book is clear, that we might become Christians, and live forever with Jesus in heaven.
