Knowing God – 'The LORD'

The New International Version (NIV) of Bibles we use at church were published in 2011. Unfortunately in the explanatory notes of our Bibles we are not told about some of the features of this translation. When the previous version of the NIV was published in 1984 the explanatory notes mention why sometimes in our Bibles we read the word 'LORD' (in lower caps), and sometimes we read the word 'Lord' (no caps). They may sound the same when we read it but the case tells us they mean very different things. The word 'Lord' simply means 'master', maybe over a household or over land. But the word 'LORD' indicates the covenant name of God. Our passage in Exodus this morning show us the moment God reveals his personal name to Moses at the burning bush. Exodus 3:14-15 show us the special relationship God has with Moses, and the people God rescued through him.
