One of the most common prayers I hear is the prayer for peace in our warring world. Aside from the heavily publicised wars in the Ukraine and the Middle East, there are many nations around the world who are hostile toward one another across thin man-made borders. At any one time there may be dozens of wars around the world occurring between nations, or even within nations, which we ought to bring before our God in prayer.
